



# School Rules

## General

Be safe	Obey the school rules. Listen to staff. Follow instructions.
Be special	Explore life's opportunities. Avoid mediocrity.
Be ambitious	What is the best life you can imagine, for you personally and with others?
Be moral	Ask yourself what is right and wrong.
Be polite	'Please,' 'Excuse me,' 'Sorry,' etc. Avoid sighing, tutting and eye-rolling.

Be healthy	Eat well, drink well, sleep well. Do sport and activities. Give all medicine to staff.
Be friendly	No bullying, violence, fighting or play fighting.
Be international	Use English to talk to everyone, especially in lessons. No phones during meals.
Be tolerant	Everyone is different. Respect and enjoy it!
Be smart	Wear uniform properly and proudly. Wrong uniform may mean no lessons.
Be punctual	Come on time for all registrations, meals, lessons and activities, etc.
Be sober	No alcohol, smoking or drugs for any students, anytime, anywhere.
Be tidy	No mess, reckless damage or vandalism. Keep bedrooms, classrooms, etc tidy.
Be honest	No lying, stealing or keeping things secret (medicine, smoking, etc).
Be streetwise	Cross roads carefully. Take care in town with strangers, money, etc.
Be controlled	No public displays of romantic affection (holding hands, hugging, kissing, etc).
Be locatable	Always sign out and in. Carry your phone, and answer if called.
Be allowed	Parents must email permission if you want to go out alone or leave Newbury.
Be prepared	Bring all your school books, stationery, homework, etc to breakfast and prep.
Be calm	Walk on the stairs (don't run or jump) and move around school sensibly.
Be helpful	There is always something more you can do for others.

## Residence

Be careful	Turn off electricity, unplug appliances. No electricity in bathrooms! No fire!
Be lawful	Do not play with fire alarms, and never cover them. Police may come!
